Division of Fire at a Glance

1. **Hydrant Testing** -2,300 hydrants tested over two months.
2. **Fire Prevention Inspections**-1700 inspections performed by line personal, Matrix uses a number of 1 hour for vacant buildings to 1.5 hours for regular inspections.
3. **Hose Testing**-28,760 feet of hose was tested.
4. **Pump Testing**-annual pump testing of 8 pieces of equipment.
5. **Ladder Testing**-Every ground ladder is tested by the Division of Fire.
6. **Station Maintenance**-Painting, Minor Repair, Snow Removal, Grass, Landscaping, Etc...
7. **Equipment Maintenance**-Making sure our equipment is in working order. Cleaning of Equipment.
8. **SCBA Testing and Repair**-All repair and maintenance done by Firefighters.
9. **Training** (Fire and EMS)-24,581 hours. Training Hours/Line FF 390 hours, Training Hours/month/FF 32 hours

Services Provided to the Citizens

1. **Fire Investigation**-16 hours per fire, Line personal investigate 75% of all fires and 49% of all fires determined to be incendiary.
2. **Fire Safety Programs**-Schools, Churches, Safety Town, Smoke Detector installation and maintenance. ECT.
3. **Fire Education Programs**-Stop drop and role, 911, How to get out alive.
4. **Special Details**.-Football Games, Soccer Tournament, Fire Works, ECT.

*Conclusion

Middletown Division of Fire Should Strive to Establish Repose times and Staffing in accordance to National Recognized Standards.-Use NFPA 1710 as a guide of what we want for the Fire Department to provide the best possible safety for the citizens of Middletown.

Middletown fire and emergency services currently **fail** to meet federal regulatory and national industry standards. The Division of fire has stretched the staffing of the division of fire to the limit. Any further reductions may have catastrophic consequences.
